

SPRING GOLF TRIP 34th ANNUAL

Gentlemen:

I was finally able to finalize our plans for The Golf Trip. My contact person at Pine Needles for at least the last 20 years retired last year. I have had nothing but trouble since that time trying to schedule our trip and our meals. I have attached the following:

1. Initial Quotas Calculation (also includes Southern Pines Invitational Tournament Rules of Play 2025); and
2. Golf Trip 2025 Tee Times and Pairings.

The pairings for the tee times were picked randomly out of a hat by assigning a number to each twosome and placing in a grid. The Sunday round will be determined based on standings at the time. Please note lunch and dinner information is also included on the tee times and pairings list.

When I finalized the trip back in October, I was told that one of the two lodges we were using (the Fairway Lodge) would not be available on Wednesday. However, a month ago, I was told by my new reservation contact that the Fairway Lodge was available and I confirmed that by e-mail on two occasions. However, earlier this week, I was told the Fairway Lodge will not be available on Wednesday evening. Craig Eury, my new contact, profusely apologized and said that those staying in the Fairway Lodge on Thursday through Sunday can stay in the Mid Pines Inn, and that Pine Needles would comp this stay which includes breakfast. I have attached a copy of my letter dated March 20, 2025 to Craig Eury with a rooming list which confirmed that both lodges were available. Since that has now changed, those of you staying in the Fairway Lodge will need to decide whether you want to stay one night in the Mid Pines Inn, or stay somewhere else, or simply arrive on Thursday morning. Compared to the trouble I have had scheduling our meals, this is a minor screwup. I am really disappointed in how this trip has

proceeded so far, but I am hopeful that things will even out and we will still have a good trip. The bottom line is those of you staying in the Fairway Lodge can have a free night at Mid Pines, or choose to go another route.


