Gentlemen:

The Golf Trip is only a week away. The first official tee time is on Thursday, April 20, 2023 at 1:00 p.m. at Pine Needles. Please remember that you can check in on Wednesday afternoon for an extra \$99.00. I advised the front desk that I thought everyone would be checking in on Wednesday, but if you plan to arrive on Thursday, let me know as soon as possible.

I have attached initial point quotas, rules, and a tee times and pairings sheet. The pairings are totally random based on team names my wife pulled from my old, retired Surf Club hat and placed into a grid.

The quest for the Turtle will again require a \$200.00 entry fee. Assuming we have 16 golfers, the daily payouts will be \$250.00 for 1<sup>st</sup>, \$150.00 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, and \$100.00 for 3<sup>rd</sup>. On the four day tournament, the payouts will be \$600.00 for 1<sup>st</sup>, \$300.00 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, and \$200.00 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, and \$100.00 for 4<sup>th</sup>. Golfers under the age of 65 will play the standard tees at both courses. Those golfers over 65 may play the senior tees with an adjustment based on handicap and slope. Mike Penland, Dennis McClane, and Joe Huie have already had the adjustment so their points are based on previous results from the senior tees.

Please remember to bring a sport coat and your medal for dinner each night. New golfers will be presented with their Turtle medal at dinner on Thursday. I would recommend that everyone take a look at the website ([www.dimpledorbn.net](http://www.dimpledorbn.net)) at your convenience. Dan has updated the website with new information, and a moving tribute to our late friend, Toby Hyke.
